

# **EAST MIDLANDS STAFFORDSHIRE BULL TERRIER CLUB**

(agreed minimum criteria for Judging Lists)

**A1 LIST** For those persons whom the E.M.S.B.T. Club would support as having the ability and experience to judge the breed and so award Kennel Club Challenge Certificates, such persons must have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed and must have completed their first appointment.

**A2 LIST** For those persons whom the E.M.S.B.T. Club would support, having fulfilled all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list. (Or who have been approved but not yet completed their first time appointment)

**A3 LIST** For those persons whom the E.M.S.B.T. Club would support, having been recommended by a Breed Council or Breed Club as being suitable to award CCs in the breed but not yet approved by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 List.

(Breed Specialist)

1. Must have a minimum of 8 years judging experience in the breed prior to the date of the nomination.
2. Must have judged at least three Breed Club Shows.
3. Must have judged a minimum of 100 classes of Staffordshire Bull Terriers
4. 50 of the 100 classes judged to be out-with a 50 mile radius of home town.
5. Must have judged a minimum of 300 dogs (actual)
6. Each sex must have been judged at Breed Club level.
7. Save in exceptional circumstances must have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their 1st entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book.
8. Must have stewarded for a minimum period of 3 years and at 12 shows.
9. Must have attended a Seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on KC Regulations and Judging Procedures. (KC Policy as of 1.7.2001)
10. Must have attended a Seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Confirmation and Movement. (KC Policy as of 1.7.2001)
11. Must have attended at least 1 Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant KC Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

## **A3 LIST**

(Non specialist)

1. Must have a minimum of 8 years judging experience in the breed and must have the support of the Club.
2. Must have judged at least 2 separate Staffordshire Bull Terrier Breed Club/Society Shows.
3. Must have judged Staffordshire Bull Terriers with evidence of an adequate geographical spread of appointments of which a minimum of 40 classes to be not less than 50 miles from home town.
4. Must have judged a minimum of **80** classes of Staffordshire Bull Terriers.
5. Must have judged a minimum of 240 Staffordshire Bull Terriers (actual).
6. Each sex must have been judged at Breed Club level.

7. Must have awarded CCs in at least one other recognized breed.
8. Must have attended at a minimum of 3 Staffordshire Bull Terrier Judging Seminars and passed a minimum of 1 assessment on Staffordshire Bull Terriers.

**B LIST For those persons whom the E.M.S.B.T. Club would support to judge the breed at shows without CCs, or Open shows.**

1. Must have a minimum of 4 years judging experience.
2. Must have judged a minimum of 25 classes of Staffordshire Bull Terriers with dogs actually present.
3. Must have judged a minimum of 75 dogs (actual).
4. Must have judged a minimum of 4 KC recognized Shows.
5. Must have attended a minimum of 1 Staffordshire Bull Terrier Breed specific Judging Seminar.

**C LIST For aspirant Judges who have shown an interest in the Breed and have the support of the E.M.S.B.T Club.**
