



CONDITIONS

If you decide you would like to adopt a Stafford, the procedure is as follows:

1. An authorised member off the rescue will interview you, probably in your own home. This interview will be relatively in-depth and you should be prepared to answer some personal questions.
2. Be prepared for the fact that we may attempt to look into your background and previous history with animals before we offer you a Stafford.
3. You will be required to sign an agreement between yourself and the LBTR before taking possession of any animal. This contract is legal and binding.
4. You cannot breed from any Rescue dog. To do so would be against the Kennel Clubs code of ethics.
5. The dog will be an LSBTRdog for the rest of its life. Should you; for any reason, become unable to look after a rescue dog any longer, you **MUST** return it to the LSBTR. You must not sell the dog, give it away or have it destroyed (except in an emergency for humane reasons, and only on a veterinary surgeons advice).

Any other fund-raising ideas or suggestions will be greatly appreciated, or perhaps you could hold a fund-raiser of your own.

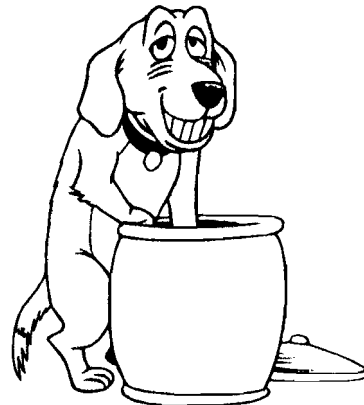


THE RESCUE STAFFORD

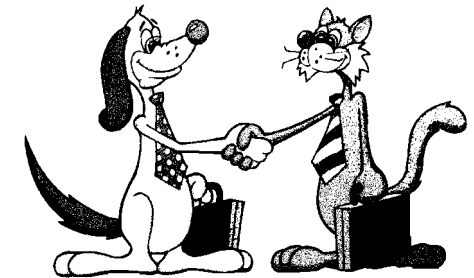
